### TRAFFIC & ROADS

The Parish Councils of Hilldale, Mawdesley, Bispham and Rufford with Holmeswood are campaigning for an enforceable weight restriction on the B5246 [Lancaster Lane, Chorley Rd, Robin Lane, Hall Lane Meadow Lane and Church Road] to limit the use of the road by large HGVs. Traffic speed in the Village is getting worse again. The 30 mph limit applies to the whole of Chorley Rd as well as every other street in the Village. Please keep to the limit so that everyone is safer.
